### Professional Coach Training Program: Application Process

Applications are now being accepted for the Inaugural Psychosynthesis Coach Training Program at Synthesis San Francisco, beginning in April 2017.

#### The Program Application process steps:

- Step 1. Completion of a program application form which includes work and education history.
- Step 2. Completion of personal statement.
- Step 3. An interview with one or more Senior Faculty.
- Step 4. Completion of Scholarship and work-study Applications, if applicable:

Scholarship/work-study applications need to be submitted at the time of program application, and will be considered separately, upon acceptance into the program.

#### **Priority Admission**

- a) Applications with *Priority Admission* acceptance will be received through **March 25, 2017** including applicable Scholarship/Work-Study Applications.
- Applications will be reviewed and interviews arranged in order of receipt and acceptance notification will be sent in order of completed applications/interviews.
- c) If accepted into the program, a full, non-refundable deposit of \$250 (which will be applied to your total tuition) must be received **upon enrollment** to secure your place.
- d) Payment of full tuition for standard admission includes a 10% reduction when paid by March 30, 2017

#### Scholarship Opportunities for Synthesis SF 2017-2018 Training

Synthesis SF will be offering scholarship and work-study for those who are training in our inaugaral program as psychosynthesis coaches. We will be offering full and partial scholarship and work exchange opportunities to assist with tuition to anyone who applies.

We are committed to make training available to all who are called to this program and will work with you to find a financial arrangement to make this possible.

There are two scholarship streams and a work-study option - you may select as many options as are applicable:

#### ◆ Full Scholarship

A limited number of full scholarships are available. These cover full basic tuition. You will be required to pay the \$250, non-refundable, non-transferable deposit, to secure your enrollment and an additional \$250 at the start of "Part 1", "Part 2 "and "Part 3" training cycles, to cover resources and related program materials.

#### ◆ Partial Scholarship

We are offering partial scholarships of \$2500 - 5000 to help offset tuition costs. You will be required to pay the \$250, non-refundable, non-transferable deposit, to secure your enrollment and any amount remaining after the scholarship offset - you may pay this amount in full or prior to the start of each cycle: "Parts 1, 2 & 3".

#### ♦ Work-Study

Work-Study is available to offset tuition costs. We will have opportunities for teaching and research assistance, as well as for help with administrative, training facility setup/breakdown, operations, etc.
